Being Great By Jesus' Definition

I. Introduction:

- A. The desire to be seen as great is not a new problem among mankind (**Isaiah** 14:12-15).
 - 1. This was the king of Babylon (Isaiah 14:4).
 - 2. No matter how high Babylon got to, humility was coming (**Jeremiah 51:44-49**).
- B. Some want to be exalted so much that they take measures to exalt themselves (**Obadiah 1:1-4**).
 - 1. Remember Diotrephes (III John 1:9-11).
 - 2. Think about the scribes and Pharisees (Matthew 23:1-12).
- II. Body: **Mark 10:35-45**
 - A. What did Jesus say in the context of washing His disciples's feet (**John 13:16**)?
 - 1. Jesus, the Lord of lords; King of kings (I Timothy 6:14-15), recognized His place (John 8:48-50).
 - 2. Jesus said the Father is greater than Him (John 14:28).
 - B. Let this mind be in you (**Philippians 2:3-9**).
 - 1. Using our freedom in Christ to be servants (**Galatians 5:13**).
 - 2. As we see Paul did for the furtherance of the Gospel (I Corinthians 9:19-23 and II Corinthians 4:5).
 - 3. Keeping our minds on Jesus as our example (Romans 15:1-3).
 - C. Think about Jesus talking about those that are least being great (Luke 9:48).
 - 1. Singing "How Great I Am" to God doesn't put you on high (**Luke 18:9-14**).
 - 2. Consider what Jesus taught about being like children (Matthew 18:1-4).
- III. Conclusion: Understand that, by Jesus' definition, being chief among men means you are a servant (Matthew 20:26-28 and Luke 22:24-27).
